Actors are requested to prepare a one-minute memorized song. Please bring sheet music as an accompanist will be provided. Prerecorded accompaniment is not permitted. Actors may be asked to do a cold reading from the script and some improvisation and movement. Callbacks will be held Monday, September 8 from 5:30 to 10:00 pm. Performances are November 7 - 23, 2014, Fridays and Saturdays at 7:30 p.m. and Saturdays and Sundays at 2:00 p.m.

All participants must be at least 10 years old and not yet 20 years old by November 23, 2014, AND actors as young as 7 (by November 23, 2014) will be considered for some of the children's roles. Character descriptions and all other information is available on the YAE web site. Rehearsals are Mondays and Wednesdays from 5:30 – 7:30pm and Saturdays from 10am to 2pm beginning Wednesday, September 10. All cast and parents must attend a mandatory welcome meeting on Wednesday, September 10 from 6:00 to 7:00 pm. If cast, there is a \$180 participation fee. Financial Assistance is available.
